Student cards will arrive on Monday . The Student Council carried out a food survey with the students for the new school canteen. The results will be used to inform canteen food provision.

4. Building Subcommittee and Working Group

The meeting has been moved to Friday week. Emer Nowlan couldn't attend the original date. First planning decision on Fassaroe site is expected in August. The Woodbrook location is considered better for wider number of students. The DES will be final arbiter on the location of the school. Dialogue with politicians will be crucial. Completion doesn't look likely for a significant period of time.

5. Allocations DES - Allocation is 34.75 whole time teachers for 2022/23. This was received on the 7<sup>th</sup> April.

We are applying for curricular concessions to compensate for the smaller classrooms and the fact that we are capped at 60 per year group, which limits our ability to provide options for students. Our Additional Educational Needs Hours have increased from 146 – 190 hours.

### 6. Policy

Staff are working on the Code of Behaviour. Amendments will be made by June. The Code of Behaviour will be presented to the Board meeting in June.

5 Students have enrolled at NWETSS (emergency/immediate enrolment):

Transition year: 3

Second year: 2

Extra provision for EAL

CPD for Trauma response education completed (4 hours), resources shared at staff meeting and on Teams.

Whole school response:

1) Community Hub afternoon for Ukrainian Refugees in Bray (April 8th). In conversation with them, emergence of need for EAL support for adults and therapeutic services for children.

2) Art Therapy for children in emergency accommodation in Bray. Every Wednesday until end of school year 4-5:30 with 4 voluntary professionals (vetted). (Liaison - Darren O'Sullivan – programme coordinator).

3) In conjunction with Art Therapy for children, EAL classes running at the same time for parents of children participating in Art therapy; adults in emergency accommodation in Bray; other parents in our school community living in direction provision. Every Wednesday until the end of school year 4-5:30pm. Volunteers are school based and EAL certified. (Liaison – Stacey Finn).
